Abhay Bakaya tours flash flood hit Gulshanabad and Asraarabad areas in Sidhra

Jammu, Aug. 04 : Apni Party General Secretary Youth Wing, and Spokesperson, Abhay Bakaya today toured the flash - flood hit Gulshanabad and Asraarabad residential colonies in Sidhra that has affected several families.

As per a press release, Abhay accompanied by the Party leader Shakti Devi, Salma Begum and others met the people from flood hit areas in Gulshanabad, and Asraarabad areas in ward number 71, Sidhra.

During his interaction with the flood affected area, Abhay expressed his deep concern over the ignorant attitude of the authorities even after knowing that the people have suffered losses following heavy rains, and flash floods.

"There is no proper road connectivity in the area whereas the flash flood adds more problems for the people in these areas. The authorities should have surveyed the areas to lay crate work / stone protection wall to protect the residential houses in both the colonies from the flood," he said.

He said that the authorities apparently seemed

unmoved with the devastating floods every year, and hence, there was no crate work / protection work on the nallah that passes through the area.

He also raised concern over the unscheduled power cuts, irregular drinking water,

poor basic amenities, and the poor road connectivity to these areas of ward number 71 where the people have been living for the last 15 to 20 years.

He demanded immediate intervention of the authorities to take preventive measures

for the people living along the water body that has become a threat to their lives, and properties.

He also demanded the basic amenities should also be improved with the 24/7 electricity supply system and regular clean drinking water.

Centre Issues Guidelines On Transporting Organs For First Time

NEW DELHI, Aug 4 : The Union Health Ministry for the first time has come out with SOPs for transporting organs seamless transport of human organs through various modes of travel such as air, road, railways and waterways.

The Standard Operating Procedure issued by the government which will serve as a guiding document for those involved in organs transplants across the country.

"By streamlining organ transport process, we aim to maximise the utilisation of precious organs and offer hope to countless patients awaiting life-saving transplants.

"These SOPs are a roadmap for organ retrieval and transplant institutions

across the country ensuring adherence to best practices and quality standards," Union Health Secretary Apurva Chandra said.

A live organ needs to be transported between hospitals when both the organ donor and the organ recipient are in different hospitals either within the same city or in different cities.

According to the SOPs for transportation by air, airlines carrying human cadaveric organs can request the Air Traffic Control for priority take-off and landing of the aircraft and arrange front-row seats.

They can also request priority reservation and a provision for late check-in for medical personnel transporting organs.

The source airport will inform and communicate to the destination airport to facilitate the arrival process, according to the SOPs.

The flight captain may make an in-flight announcement that human organs are being transported, the guidelines stated.

The SOPs said that trolleys can be arranged for carrying the organ box from the aircraft to the ambulance on arrival by the airport and airline staff and in case the ambulance is allowed until the runway, the airline crew can guide and assist the accompanying medical personnel carrying the organ box to disembark from the staircase onto the runway directly and into the waiting ambulance.
